About the program

You can register for the exam online after a third-party degree verification (also online). After registering travel to Africa to take a short training course that will help you to clear the exam. You become a provisional doctor and complete a year of housemanship in Africa to become a Junior Doctor.

Africa is a great destination for new medical professionals as there is a severe scarcity of medical professionals. Remunerations for a trained doctor are comparable to Western countries, after 2-3 years of practice, if the professional has the skills needed for Africa. It's also easy to move to the UK/US as moving to the West is very popular.

Timeline for June/July exam

- 1. Registration with our company: Register by 15th of March
- 2. Registration for licensing exam: Online registration by uploading copy of completed medical training for verification and another copy to the licensing authority at destination country. Two weeks are required for registration.
- 3. Visa & Tickets: 5 working days required for issue of special Visa
- 4. Licensing exam schedule: Licensing exam is over two days based on MCQ's and Viva Voce scheduled every year around June/July every year. Results in 48 hours.
- 5. Licensing exam preparation: Reach the destination country by end of April for 2 month training for licensing exam.
- 6. Housemanship: Within a week of clearing licensing exam, offer for one year housemanship will be made to you for Housemanship by the local hospital.
- 7. Junior Doctor: After successful completion of 1 year housemanship, you will formally become a Junior Doctor eligible to practice at any of the Hospitals in the destination country or nearby countries where the license is recognised. You are also eligible to licensing exam of UK/US.

Services provided
